Announcement Timetable:

- ◆ Bulletin # 1: 2012 November 15th - (done)

- ◆ **Dead Line** for Teams' Registration: **2013 April 15th**

Competitions: Schedules will be defined by CIRILH after the dead line.

- ◆ **Junior Women Championships:** As it is the first Junior Women Championships competition will be define depending number of teams attending.
- ◆ **Junior Men Championships:** Depending on the number of teams attending there will be 2, 3 or 4 groups playing a round robin to qualify 8 teams competing for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination.
- ◆ **Senior Women Championships:** Probably 2 groups playing a round robin to qualify eight (8) teams competing for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination.
- ◆ **Senior Men Championships:** Four groups (A, B, C, D) playing a round robin. Group A and B will qualify 6 teams, Group C and D will qualify 2 teams. These eight (8) teams will compete for gold, silver and bronze medals by direct elimination. All other teams will begin a new competition named World Cup for National teams with gold, silver and bronze medals.
- ◆ Schedule Senior Men: draft for A and B group see page at the end.

7. REGISTRATION RULES

- ◆ **Team size** : shall consist of no more than 14 players plus 2 goalies.
- ◆ **Registration** : The 2013 FIRS, the OFFICIAL World Championships for InLine Hockey are open to In Line Hockey Teams from all the National Federations affiliated with the FIRS, provided that they confirm their entry prior to : **15 April 2013**.
- ◆ **Senior Minimum Age** : is fourteen (14) years as calculated on January 1st in the year of the Championship.
- ◆ **Junior Age** : The official FIRS Junior Championship age level for both male and female players is age fourteen (14) through nineteen (19). Calculated as: Under 20 on 2013 December 31th. That means players born on: 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999 are eligible to play in 2013.
- ◆ **Nationality** : All participating team members will be required to prove appropriate nationality and age on the day prior to the scheduled games by means of a valid passport issued from the country being represented.

8. REGISTRATION FEES

- ◆ **Entry Fees** : According to CIRILH Rules for World Championships the entry fee is one thousand Swiss Francs (1,000 CHF.). The amount of 1,000 CHF is not including transfer fee so you have to add the bank fees.
- ◆ **How to make payment** : Fees, are to be paid directly to CIRILH, the FIRS In-Line Hockey Committee, in USA dollars or Euros at the international exchange rate at the time of payment. This fee shall be applied separately for each male and female team participating in the World Championships. Payment of the entry fee must be received by deadline date to assure acceptance and an accurate count of the number of teams placed in the games schedule. It benefits all teams when we insist that a firm commitment for appearance is made by **15 April 2013**, prior to the formulation of a games schedule.

9. WELCOME – OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The delegations will be welcomed on behalf of the Organizing Committee upon arrival in **Los Angeles International Airport (LAX)**. They will be brought to the host Hotels. The official languages are English and Spanish. Interpretation from and into other languages should be organised by the delegations. All documents will be in English and Spanish.

As you know we have made housing arrangements for all International teams (FIRS Jrs & Srs. as well as JO's) to stay at one of the "Headquarter Hotel". They have a choice of Anaheim Hilton or Anaheim Clarion <http://www.gettravel.com/FIRS/accommodation.shtml>

Hilton rate is \$129 includes:

Chief Referee will organize **an intenational course for future international referees on July 6th and 7th**, and a course of revision for the referees going to do the job the second week of the championships on July 14th. Then the Chief Referee will maintain permanent contact with referees during the competitions.
