INTRODUCTION:

This will be the fifth edition of the Masters World Cup (former VETERAN WORLD CUP).

The first one (2010 Bisley – UK), the second one (2011 Beroun – Czech Republic), the third one (2012 Pinerolo – Italy) and the fourth one (2013 Anglet – France) were a great success. Masters are very important for our sport.

They are trainers or club managers. CIRILH members are happy to see old timers again on the spot.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1 <u>Eligibility of Teams and Players</u>: the Masters World Cup is open to any Team of a National Federation affiliated with the FIRS provided that this National Federation gives permission to attend. Each player has to be born in 1976 or before.
- **2** <u>Team Size</u>: Team rosters will consist of a minimum of eight (8) players plus one (1) goalkeeper and a maximum of 16 players including 2 goalies.
- 3 <u>Dead Line</u>: The 2014 Masters World Cup is open to the In Line Hockey Teams from all the National Federations affiliated with the FIRS provided that they confirm their entry prior to: 30th April 2014. Teams must confirm their registration by returning the Application Form (page 4) to: <u>alberto.lastrucci@gmail.com</u> with cc to: <u>cirilh@me.com</u>
- **4** <u>Nationality of Players</u>: players should be of the same nationality as the Team they are playing for.

All participating Team members will be required to prove appropriate nationality and age at the World Cup Meeting prior to the scheduled games, by a valid passport issued from the Country being represented. ID card with mention of nationality will be accepted.

- **5** Referees: Each participating Team should supply a Referee (over 38) able to do the job at a good level, according to the spirit of Masters World Cup. *If unable to supply a referee, please inform CIRILH.*
- **6** <u>Financial Conditions</u>: each participating Team will be responsible for its own travelling, lodging and living expenses.

The entry fee to be paid directly to CIRILH is 300 CHF Swiss Francs (US \$ or Euro at the international rate in effect at the time of payment).

7 <u>Structure of the Masters World Cup</u>: the Masters World Cup will be structured to give the attending Teams maximum games and fun. No more than 2 games/day. Depending on the number of teams, the organization may plan different pools.

CIRILH will allow

- •3 points to a Team winning a game
- •1 point to each Team in a tie game
- •0 point to a Team loosing a game
- **8** Rules of the Game: the CIRILH Committee shall have full governing control over the Masters World Cup, which must be played in accordance with

- FIRS/CIRILH Rules of the Game
- •FIRS Statutes
- FIRS Administrative Rules
