Event Notice

This is an NZIHA sanctioned event.

Invitations are invited from individuals/teams and the following rules apply;

Player eligibility:

MASTERS and VETERANS (30+) and WOMEN (any age)

All players must be registered with NZIHA. If players are not registered with NZIHA, nor belong to a registered club, they must sign the form attached seeking an associate membership (free) for NZIHA that covers this one event as a player, and players must agree to abide by the NZIHA rules, code of conduct, and rules of this event.

Players/goalies can register individually, or, if you do not have a full team, contact us as we can most certainly help place you in a team.

Players/goalies may play for more than one team throughout the tournament.

Teams can be any mix of Masters/Vets/Women. Depending on player ability, newer players younger than 30 years old may be considered.

Each game will comprise of 2 x 20 minute halves, with 2 min break half-time. Each team is permitted 1minute time out per game.

Referees will be supplied for each game.
